



## 2006 STATE ELECTION INITIATIVE

*Released on Wednesday 15th March 2006*

This 2006 State Election Initiative pledges \$2 million for five projects around the electorate of Lyons.

Note that the Greens Lyons Initiative Package does not include construction of roads or new council infrastructure because they will be funded by other sources.

### ***Lyons Initiative Package***

Having recognised the need for resourcing of new and existing projects in the electorate of Lyons, the Tasmanian Greens are pledging to contribute funding to a range of exciting projects, which are designed to enhance local employment, skills development in tradition activities and value adding of local produce.

**\$400.000 for each of the following projects:**

- The Derwent Valley Railway
- The Callington Mill in Oatlands
- A Stonemasonry College in Ross
- A Centre of Excellence for Mine Remediation in Queenstown
- Tourism related projects on the East Coast - upgrading of existing tourism infrastructure on the Tasman, in Sorell, Glamorgan/Spring Bay and Break O'Day municipalities.
